A high level of protection of the environment taken as a whole by, in particular, preventing or, where that is not practicable, reducing emissions into the air, water and land.

The company will endeavour to comply with all applicable environmental legislation.

The company is committed to pollution prevention and aims, where practicable, to reduce the use of potentially polluting materials used in our processes.
The company will work to continually reduce any adverse impact on the environment caused by its activities.

The company will set targets and monitor Environmental performance with the aim of continual improvement and ultimately sustainable development.

In order to achieve this, Interfoam will implement and maintain an Environmental Management System that complies with ISO 14001.

The Directors and Managers will review the Environmental Policy annually and revise it as appropriate.
